AFFIDAVIT

I, John McEown, CPA, CA, CIRP (Licensed Insolvency Trustee, Chartered Insolvency and Restructuring Professional), of 110-744 West Hastings Street, in the city of Vancouver, British Columbia, SWEAR THAT:

1. I am the president and sole director of McEown and Associates Ltd. and was formerly a director and employee of Boale, Wood & Company Ltd.
2. McEown and Associates Ltd. is the court appointed monitor of the plaintiff, All Canadian Investment Corporation ("ACIC") pursuant to the provisions of the *Companies Creditors' Arrangements Act* ("CCAA Proceedings"). By order made November 22, 2018, the monitor was granted enhanced powers with respect to the management and operations of ACIC. Attached and marked as **Exhibit "A"** is a copy of the Order made November 22, 2018.
3. I have had conduct of the file on behalf of both Boale, Wood & Company Ltd. and McEown and Associates Ltd. throughout the CCAA Proceedings and as such

have personal knowledge of the facts hereinafter deposed, except where such facts are stated to be based upon information and belief and where so stated I do verily believe them to be true.

4. In my capacity as monitor and for the purposes of preparing this affidavit I have reviewed:
 - (a) the books and records of ACIC (the "Records") relating to the loan advances made to the defendants, Ronald Weninger, also known as Ron Weninger ("Mr. Weninger") and Elfrieda Weninger ("Mrs. Weninger");
 - (b) the pleadings filed in these proceedings; and
 - (c) the list of documents produced by ACIC for the purposes of these proceedings.
5. Based on my involvement with the business and operations of ACIC and my review of its files and documents, I believe that the Records, including the documents which were sourced from the Records and are attached to this affidavit:
 - (a) were made or kept in the usual and ordinary course of ACIC's business; and
 - (b) it was the usual and ordinary course of ACIC's business to record in those documents statements of fact at the time they occurred or within a reasonable time thereafter.
6. In accordance with its usual practice, ACIC maintained loan statements for each of the borrowers that funds were advanced to. The information contained in the loan statements comes from its source documents and includes:
 - (a) the amounts and dates of loan advances and repayments;
 - (b) a running balance of outstanding principal;
 - (c) the amounts and dates of interest accruing on the outstanding advances;

- (d) interest payments received;
 - (e) total principal and interest outstanding; and
 - (f) the interest rate of a particular loan.
7. I am advised by Mr. Jeremy West, counsel for ACIC, that as at the date of this affidavit the defendants have not produced a list of documents in the proceedings.

ACIC

8. ACIC is a mortgage investment corporation which has been in business since 1998. Its business was to provide loans to borrowers which were to be secured by, amongst other things, registered, unregistered and equitable mortgages on real property.

The Weninger Preferred Shares

9. Based on my review of the Records I understand that Mr. Weninger and Mrs. Weninger purchased preferred shares in ACIC as follows:
- (a) \$100,000 on June 11, 2008; and
 - (b) \$100,000 on February 5, 2009.
- (the "Preferred Shares").
10. As at the date of this affidavit the Weningers continue to own the entirety of the Preferred Shares.

The Loans

11. Based on my review of the Records I understand the following.
12. Mr. and Mrs. Weninger are businesspersons who were involved in construction projects and reside at 1225 Mountain Avenue, Kelowna, British Columbia.

First Loan Agreement

13. On or about September 4, 2012, ACIC (as lender) and Mr. Weninger (as borrower) entered into a written loan agreement (the “**First Loan Agreement**”) the terms of which included, *inter alia*:
- (a) ACIC would advance monies to Mr. Weninger up to a maximum amount of \$300,000 (the “**First Advance**”);
 - (b) the First Loan Agreement would be recorded in a promissory note;
 - (c) interest would accrue on the First Advance at a rate of 12% per annum;
 - (d) interest under the First Loan Agreement would be paid monthly commencing on November 1, 2012; and
 - (e) the term of the loan would be for 6 months with repayment due March 31, 2013.

Attached and marked as **Exhibit “B”** is a true copy of a letter recording the terms of the First Loan Agreement which was signed by Mr. Weninger.

14. Commencing November 8, 2012, ACIC made the following advances to Mr. Weninger in accordance with the terms of the First Loan Agreement:
- (a) \$50,000.00 on November 8, 2012;
 - (b) \$100,000.00 on December 14, 2012;
 - (c) \$50,000.00 on March 11, 2013; and
 - (d) \$100,000.00 on March 14, 2013.
15. ACIC periodically sent letters to Mr. Weninger requesting payment of interest due and owing under the First Loan Agreement. Attached and marked collectively as **Exhibit “C”** are four such letters dated April 5, 2013; April 29, 2013; May 30, 2013 and July 10, 2013.
16. The Records indicate that between November 2012 and June 2013 Mr. Weninger regularly made interest payments on the First Loan Agreement. Attached and

marked as **Exhibit “D”** is a true copy of ACIC’s Loan Statement dated March 31, 2020 for the Weninger loans (the “Loan Statement”).

17. As recorded on the Loan Statement, on or about June 28, 2013, Mr. Weninger paid the sum of \$300,000.00 together with outstanding interest to ACIC representing the balance of the monies due and owing under the First Loan Agreement.

Second Loan Agreement

18. On or about September 18, 2013, ACIC (as lender) and Mr. Weninger (as borrower) entered into a written loan agreement (the “**Second Loan Agreement**”) the terms of which included, *inter alia*:
 - (a) ACIC would advance monies to Mr. Weninger up to a maximum amount of \$200,000.00 (the “**Second Advance**”);
 - (b) the Second Loan Agreement would be secured by a promissory note;
 - (c) interest would accrue on the Second Advance at a rate of 12% per annum.
 - (d) interest under Second Loan Agreement would be paid monthly commencing on November 1, 2013; and
 - (e) the term of the loan would be for 6 months with repayment due March 20, 2014.

Attached and marked as **Exhibit “E”** is a true copy of the Second Loan Agreement signed by Mr. Weninger.

19. On September 18, 2013, Mr. Weninger executed a promissory note in favour of ACIC securing the amounts due and owing under the Second Loan Agreement. Attached and marked as **Exhibit “F”** is a true copy of this promissory note.
20. On September 20, 2013, ACIC forwarded \$100,000.00 to Mr. Weninger in accordance with the terms of the Second Loan Agreement. Attached and marked as **Exhibits “G”** and **“H”** are true copies of a letter from ACIC to Mr. Weninger

enclosing a cheque for \$100,000.00 and a bank draft from ACIC in favour of Mr. Weninger dated September 20, 2013.

21. ACIC sent periodic reminders to Mr. Weninger requesting payment of the interest due and owing under the Second Loan Agreement. Attached here and marked collectively as **Exhibit "I"** are twelve such letters dated November 4, 2013; December 3, 2013; January 2, 2014; February 6, 2014; March 3, 2014; April 2, 2014; May 5, 2014; June 6, 2014; July 3, 2014; August 13, 2014; September 4, 2014; and October 6, 2014.
22. Mr. Weninger regularly made interest payments to ACIC for amounts due and owing under the terms of the Second Loan Agreement as recorded in the Loan Statement.

Third Loan Agreement

23. On or about October 10, 2014, ACIC (as lender) and Mr. and Mrs. Weninger (as borrowers) entered into a written loan agreement (the **"Third Loan Agreement"**) the terms of which included, *inter alia*:
 - (a) ACIC would advance \$100,000.00 to Ron and Elfrieda Weninger (the **"Third Advance"**);
 - (b) the Third Loan Agreement would be secured by a promissory note;
 - (c) the Third Advance was repayable on demand;
 - (d) interest would accrue on the Third Advance at a rate of 12% per annum;
 - (e) interest under the Third Loan Agreement would be paid monthly; and
 - (f) ACIC could, at its sole discretion, register a mortgage against title to each of the properties located at 534 and 540 Feathertop Way, Big White, BC, and legally described as:

("Lot 57")

and

Strata Lot 58 District Lot 4222 Similkameen Division

(collectively, the "**Properties**")

Attached here and marked as **Exhibit "J"** is a true copy of the Third Loan Agreement.

24. The Third Loan Agreement was used by Mr. and Mrs. Weninger to roll over the sums due and owing under the Second Loan Agreement. No new advance was made.
25. On October 10, 2014, Ron and Elfrieda Weninger each executed a promissory note in favour of ACIC securing the amounts due and owing under the Third Loan Agreement. Attached here and marked as **Exhibit "K"** is a true copy of the promissory note.
26. Based on my review of land titles office searches dated September 26, 2019, I believe that Lot 58, which was intended to provide provided security for the Third Loan Agreement was sold by Ron and Elfrieda Weninger on or about August 11, 2016. No mortgage appears to have been registered by ACIC on Lot 57. Attached here and marked as **Exhibits "L"** and **"M"** are true copies of title searches for Lot 57 and 58.
27. ACIC periodically sent reminders to Mr. Weninger for repayment of interest due and owing under the Third Loan Agreement. Attached and marked collectively as **Exhibit "N"** are six of such letters dated November 3, 2014; December 3, 2014; January 5, 2015; March 5, 2015; April 2, 2015; and July 14, 2015.
28. Mr. Weninger regularly made payments for interest due and owing under the terms of the Third Loan Agreement. These payments are noted on the Loan Statement.

Fourth Loan Agreement

29. On or about October 1, 2015, ACIC (as lender) and Mr. and Mrs. Weninger (as borrowers) entered into a written loan agreement (the “**Fourth Loan Agreement**”) the terms of which included, *inter alia*:
- (a) ACIC would advance funds to Ron and Elfrieda Weninger up to a maximum of \$130,000.00 (the “**Fourth Advance**”);
 - (b) the Fourth Advance was repayable on demand;
 - (c) interest would accrue on the Fourth Advance at a rate of 6% per annum;
 - (d) interest under the Fourth Loan Agreement would be paid monthly; and
 - (e) ACIC could, at its sole discretion, register a mortgage against title to each of the Properties.

Attached and marked as **Exhibit “O”** is a true copy the Fourth Loan Agreement.

30. The Fourth Loan Agreement was used by Mr. and Mrs. Weninger to re-pay the sums due and owing under the Third Loan Agreement together with a further advance of \$30,000.
31. On October 1, 2015, Mr. and Mrs. Weninger executed a promissory note in favour of ACIC securing the amounts due and owing under the Fourth Loan Agreement. Attached and marked as **Exhibit “P”** is a true copy of the promissory note.

Fifth Loan Agreement

32. On or about November 12, 2015, ACIC (as lender) and Mr. Weninger (as borrower) entered into a further loan agreement (the “**Fifth Loan Agreement**”) the terms of which included, *inter alia*:
- (a) ACIC would advance \$10,000.00 to Ron Weninger (the “**Fifth Advance**”);
 - (b) interest would accrue on the Fifth Advance at a rate of 7% per annum;

- (c) interest under the Fifth Loan Agreement would be paid monthly; and
- (d) the term of the loan would be 6 months with repayment due on May 12, 2016.

Attached and marked as **Exhibit “Q”** is a true copy are promissory note executed November 12, 2015 by Mr. Weninger recording the terms of the Fifth Loan Agreement.

- 33. On November 18, 2015, ACIC advanced \$10,000.00 to Mr. Weninger in accordance with the terms of the Fifth Loan Agreement.
- 34. On December 3, 2015, Mrs. Weninger emailed Wayne Blair of ACIC (the “December 3 Email”). In the December 3 Email, Elfrieda Weninger advised that Mr. Weninger had mistakenly requested a new loan agreement in entering into the Fifth Loan Agreement instead of asking for an additional advance under the Fourth Loan Agreement. The Fifth Advance was subsequently treated by ACIC on the same terms as the Fourth Loan Agreement, with interest accruing at 6% per annum rather than 7% as agreed in the Fifth Loan Agreement. Mrs. Weninger states in this email that they were borrowing the funds for a project they were carrying out in Duncan and appears to confirm that she would be billing the client for the interests that was being charged. Attached and marked as **Exhibit “R”** is a true copy of the December 3 Email.

Sixth Loan Agreement

- 35. On or about February 25, 2016, ACIC (as lender) and Mr. and Mrs. Weninger (as borrowers) entered into a loan agreement (the “**Sixth Loan Agreement**”) the terms of which included, *inter alia*:
 - (a) ACIC would advance \$20,000.00 to Mr. and Mrs. Weninger (the “**Sixth Advance**”);
 - (b) interest would accrue on the Sixth Advance at a rate of 6% per annum;
 - (c) interest under the Fourth Loan Agreement would be paid monthly; and

- (d) the term of the loan would be 6 months with repayment due on August 25, 2016.

Attached and marked as **Exhibit "S"** is a true copy of a Promissory Note dated February 25, 2016 recording the terms of the Sixth Loan Agreement.

- 36. On February 26, 2016, ACIC advanced \$20,000.00 to Mr. and Mrs. Weninger in accordance with the terms of the Sixth Loan Agreement.

Seventh Loan Agreement

- 37. On or about March 25, 2016, ACIC (as lender) and Mr. and Mrs. Weninger (as borrowers) entered into a loan agreement (the "**Seventh Loan Agreement**") the terms of which included, *inter alia*:

- (a) ACIC would advance \$20,000.00 to Mr. and Mrs. Weninger (the "**Seventh Advance**");
- (b) interest would accrue on the Seventh Advance at a rate of 6% per annum;
- (c) interest under the Seventh Loan Agreement would be paid monthly; and
- (d) the term of the loan would be 5 months with repayment due on August 26, 2016.

Attached here and marked as **Exhibit "T"** is a true copy of a Promissory Note dated March 25, 2016 recording the terms of the Seventh Loan Agreement.

- 38. On April 1, 2016, ACIC advanced \$20,000.00 to Mr. and Mrs. Weninger in accordance with the terms of the Seventh Loan Agreement.
- 39. ACIC continued to periodically send reminders to Mr. Weninger recording the amounts due and owing under the Fourth Loan Agreement, the Fifth Loan Agreement, the Sixth Loan Agreement, and the Seventh Loan Agreement (collectively, the "Outstanding Loans"). Attached and marked collectively as **Exhibit "U"** are two such letters dated October 22, 2015 and May 17, 2016.

40. Mr. and Mrs. Weninger continued to make periodic payments of the amounts due and owing on the Outstanding Loan Agreements, the last of which was made on April 30, 2016.

Acknowledgements

41. On November 15, 2017, ACIC delivered a Request for Acknowledgement to Mr. Weninger requesting that he acknowledge his indebtedness under the Outstanding Loan Agreements for principal only of \$150,000, excluding interest (the "Acknowledgement Request"). Attached and marked as **Exhibit "V"** is a copy of the letter dated November 15, 2017
42. On November 18, 2017, Mr. and Mrs. Weninger sent an endorsed letter in response to the Acknowledgement Request, Attached and marked as **Exhibit "W"** is a copy of the letter dated November 11, 2017.
43. Based on my review of the Records I have been unable to identify any payments by made by Mr. and Mrs. Weninger after April 30, 2016.

Amount due and owing as at July 15, 2022

44. Attached and marked as **Exhibit "X"** is a statement setting out the amount that will be due and owing under the terms of the Outstanding Loan Agreements as at July 15, 2022. The amount is comprised of:
- (a) the outstanding principal of \$150,000; and
 - (b) interest calculated at a rate of 6% per annum to July 15, 2022.

Defences

45. By Notice of Civil Claim filed September 27, 2019 ACIC commenced these proceedings. I have been providing counsel for ACIC with instructions in accordance with the powers granted to me in the Order made November 22, 2018.

46. On November 1, 2019 Mr. and Mrs. Weninger filed their Response to Civil Claim. They have subsequently served an Amended Response to Civil Claim filed June 27, 2022.
47. I have reviewed the Amended Response to Civil Claim in which the defendants rely on the following defences:
- (a) misrepresentation/fraud;
 - (b) unconscionability;
 - (c) good faith and fair dealing; and
 - (d) promissory estoppel.
48. As I understand the defendants' position, they deny that they are indebted to ACIC and allege that ACIC's representatives agreed that the funds advanced under the terms of the Loan Agreements would be repaid from the eventual redemption of the defendants' preferred shares in ACIC.
49. During the course of the CCAA Proceedings orders were made dealing with the status of preferred shareholders. Attached and marked as **Exhibit "Y"** is a copy of an Order made September 4, 2019 confirming that for the purposes of the CCAA Proceedings the claims of ACIC's preferred shareholders are "equity claims" as defined as defined in s.2 of the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act* R.S.C. 1985 c. C-36.
50. On January 24, 2019 Mr. Donald Bergman, of ACIC, filed an affidavit in the proceedings. Attached and marked as Exhibit "AA" to the Bergman affidavit is a list prepared from the Records, current as at January 24 2019, identifying the preferred shareholders that delivered redemption notices to ACIC (the "Redemption Request List"). The Redemption Request List includes the date on which the respective redemption notices were received by ACIC, the amount which the shareholder requested, the amounts paid and outstanding. Attached and marked as **Exhibit "Z"** is a copy of the Redemption Request List.

51. The Weningers are not identified on the Redemption Request List. I am advised by Mr. West, counsel for ACIC, that he has requested copies of any redemption requests delivered by the Weningers to ACIC. As at the date of this affidavit the Weningers have not provided copies of any redemption requests.
52. By order made February 5, 2021 ACIC's Plan of Arrangement was sanctioned in the CCAA Proceedings (the "Plan"). In accordance with the terms of the Plan, ACIC's obligations to preferred shareholders are to be paid, settled and compromised in accordance with the terms of the Plan and in particular, in accordance with the following priorities:
- (a) amounts due and owing under the Administrative Charge;
 - (b) amounts due and owing under the Director's Charge;
 - (c) amounts due and owing to Creditors;
 - (d) amounts due and owing under the Representative Council Charge; and
 - (e) distribution of the balance to Preferred Shareholders.
53. Based on the information presently available to me, it is clear that there will insufficient funds available to pay out the entirety of the preferred shareholder claims and there is likely to be a significant shortfall.
54. Mr. and Mrs. Weninger are likely to recover something in the range of 8% - 15% on the Preferred Shares under the terms of the Plan. In the event that they are not required to repay the loan advances they will be in a significantly better position than any of the other preferred shareholders.

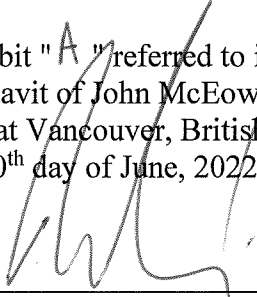

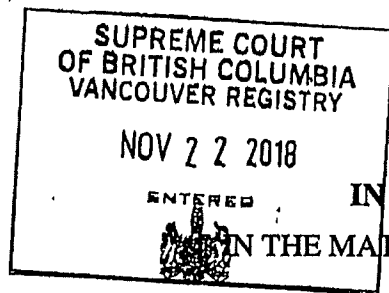

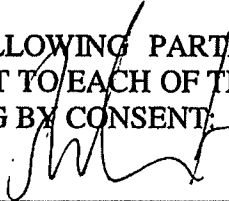
THIS COURT ORDERS that:

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4. The approval of counsel as to form listed as Schedule "A" hereto, except for counsel for the Petitioner, is hereby dispensed with.

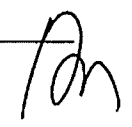
