
ON THE APPLICATION of the plaintiff, eCapital Freight Factoring, Inc. coming on for hearing at Vancouver, British Columbia, on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2026; AND ON HEARING Jeremy D. West, counsel for the plaintiff, and no one else appearing despite being served; AND UPON READING the material filed, including the Third Report of the Receiver dated March 23, 2026 (the "Third Report");

THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES THAT:

1. The activities of McEown and Associates Ltd., in its capacity as Court appointed receiver and manager of the assets, undertakings and properties of Pro West Transport Ltd. (the "Receiver"), as set out in the Third Report, are hereby approved.
2. The fees and disbursements of the Receiver and its counsel, as set out in the Third Report are hereby approved.

3. After payment of the fees and disbursements of the Receiver as herein approved, the Receiver shall pay all funds remaining in its hands:
  - (a) to the Employment Standards Branch, in payment of the priority employee claims against Pro West Transport Ltd. pursuant to s. 81.3(1) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* and the Receiver's obligations under the *Wage Earner Protection Program Act*; and
  - (b) the balance to eCapital Freight Factoring Inc.
4. Upon payment of the amounts set out in paragraph 3 hereof, the Receiver shall be discharged as Receiver of the assets, undertaking and property of Pro West Transport Ltd., provided that notwithstanding its discharge herein: (a) the Receiver shall remain Receiver for the performance of such incidental duties as may be required to complete the administration of the receivership herein; and (b) the Receiver shall continue to have the benefit of the provisions of all Orders made in this proceeding, including all approvals, protections and stays of proceedings in favour of McEown and Associates Ltd. in its capacity as Receiver.
5. Notwithstanding any provision herein, this Order shall not affect any person to whom notice of these proceedings was not delivered as required by the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* and regulations thereto, any other applicable enactment or any other Order of this Court.
